More about New Life...

New Life Recovery Center is an 10-bed, 30 day residential facility. The program offers services to individuals - both male and female - 18 years or older, who have the primary diagnosis of alcohol and/or drug dependence, and any mental illness.

New Life is dedicated to the education of, rehabilitation of, and support to individuals who suffer from the disease of addiction/co-occurring disorders, and who have the desire to attain recovery, through abstinence from alcohol and/or other drugs, and management of their co-occurring disorder.

Our program is based on the philosophy that chemical dependency/co-occurring are chronic, progressive disease that impacts the physical, mental, social and spiritual well-being of affected individuals. We are also dedicated to the philosophy that both populations can obtain recovery.

New Life is a non-smoking program, both inside and outside of the facility.

Since addiction is a family disease, family members must attend the FLASH (Families Learning And Staying Healthy) group on Mondays from 6-7:30 p.m. at the Montgomery Center in Blacksburg before they may visit on Sundays from 2-4 p.m.

Components of the New Life Recovery Center program include:

- Group therapy
- Individual therapy
- Family group
- Drug/alcohol testing
- Case Management services and 6 - 12 months of follow-up after completion of the program
- Psychiatric services (only as needed)
- Nursing services (as needed)
- AA/NA attendance
- Special activities
- Acupuncture services
- Continuum of care after program completion
